

HOLISTIC DOULA PRACTITIONER INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Purpose: To collect experiences that will further your ability to council and educate clients.

A total of 100 hours is required for graduation from the Holistic Doula Practitioner Program.

Core Requirements (50 Hours from at least three different families)

- > 10 hours Pregnancy consultation
- > 20 hours Labor in a home setting
- > 10 hours Labor in a hospital setting or birthing center
- > 5 hours Birth/Postpartum care for mother
- 5 hours Newborn Infant care

Remaining 50 Hours: May include but is not limited to the following activities:

- > Pregnancy, Labor, Birth, Postpartum and Newborn care in addition to above
- Midwife Observation Limit 10 hours
- > Labor or Postpartum Doula Observation Limit 10 hours
- > Allopathic Medicine (obstetric nurses, obstetrician, pediatrician) Limit 5 hours
- > Breastfeeding Support Groups or La Leche League classes Limit 5 hours
- Lactation Consultation Observation Limit 5 hours
- ➤ Birthing preparation classes (Bradley Method, Lamaze, etc.) Limit 5 hours
- ➤ Midwifery conferences and Birthing Seminars Limit 5 hours
- > CPR/First Aid training for infants Limit 5 hours
- Natural Birthing Political Awareness Limit 5 hours
- ➤ Marketing/Promotion Limit 5 hours
- ➢ Bodywork Therapies Limit 5 hours

You are welcome to spend more time in any of the above areas that interest you; however they cannot count toward your 100-hour total.
